On Sunday afternoon at St. Andrew's Church. Ashburton, there took piace, in conjunction with the Sunday School Festival, the dedication of a new stained glass window placed in the south aisle by the generosity of Mr. W. Michelmore-a native of Ashburton, now living at Plymouth-in memory of his brother, Richard Carlile Michelmore, who died in February last. The window is one of four placed in the aisle by the Michelmore family and like the others is the work of Mr. Fouracre, of Stone house. It is a fine four-light window, and each light contains a figure of a Saint, with some incident in the Saint's life depicted. Thus there is St. Paul preaching at Marshill; St. John engaged upon the book of the Revelations s St. Peter being commissioned by the Saviour to feed his sheep; and St. James with our Lord at the breaking of bread. Being in strong, rich colours, very harmoniously treated, the window is a rare addition to the decorations of the church.
