Will & inventory of Philip MICHELMORE

In the name of God Amen.

I, Phillip MICHELMORE of the Burrough of Liskeard, single woman, do make and ordaine this my last will and testament revoking all former wills whatsoever.

Imprim: I commend my soule into the hands of Almighty God my Maker Redeemer and Sanctifier and my body unto Christian burial.

Item: I give and devise unto John COLE my brother in law all the moietie parte and interest of me the said Phillip MICHELMORE in one barne and corthaige? lying in Lux Street in the said Burrough and also all my parte moietie and interest in one feild lying at Barrows Cross, lately both in the possession of William Burrough TAYLOR and now in the possession of James BENNITHE, mercer, to have and to hold to the said John COLE his heires and assignes for ever.

Item: I give to Johan the wife of Richard DOBSON of Tavistocke in the Countie of Devon and to her three children two shillings and six pence a peece.

All the rest of my goods and chattles not formerly given or bequeathed I give and bequeath unto John COLE by brother-in-law, whome I make and ordaine my whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament and doe hereby appoint him to pay all my just debts and legacies and to discharge my several expenses.

In witness hereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seale this twelfth day of February Anno Domini 1701.
